Amy Oliver Cooke is the Executive Vice President and Director of the Energy Policy Center for the Independence Institute, Colorado's free market, state-based think tank. She has worked in both policy and operations since 2004.

Her first adventure with policy was heading up the Transparency Project, which helped bring financial transparency to school districts and state and local governments.

In 2010, Amy moved to energy. She is one of the few state-level, free market energy policy experts. She has spoken to thousands of people across the country about everything from the controversial Clean Power Plan to strategies for fighting for affordable power.

She's famous for her provocative messaging like "Mothers In Love with Fracking" and "I'm an energy feminist because I'm pro-choice in energy sources."

She has written numerous opinion editorials, issue papers, and issue backgrounders and has been published in the Daily Caller, Townhall, Denver Post, Pueblo Chieftain, Greeley Tribune, Denver Business Journal, Denver Daily News, Liberty Ink Journal, and Wall Street Journal. She has appeared on Fox News, MSN.com, Devil's Advocate, Colorado Inside Out, and Power Hour.

Amy retired after ten years of hosting the award winning Amy Oliver Show on News Talk 1310 KFKA Monday through Friday from 9 to 11 am.

In 2008, the Colorado Broadcasters Association recognized her with the Award of Excellence for Best News Talk personality in a major market. She was recognized again in 2011 with the Award of Merit for Best News Talk personality in a major market.

Amy earned a degree in journalism in 1985 from the prestigious University of Missouri-Columbia. She also earned a graduate degree in American History from the University of Northern Colorado.

She loves living in Weld County, Colorado, with her husband retired Sheriff and current State Senator John Cooke. She is mom to Ann, Jack, and Lizzie, and stepmom to John and Rachel.

Jon Caldara hates bullies. He has dedicated his professional life to stop bullies who use the coercive power of government to take from others and force their values on those who don't share them.

Caldara (from page 3) is the President of the Independence Institute, Colorado's free-market think tank in Denver, Colorado. He also hosts radio talk programs on 630 KHOW and 850 KOA. His current affairs television program, *Devil's Advocate* with Jon Caldara, airs on Colorado Public Television Channel 12, Friday nights at 8:30.

Jon's greatest pride is being father of three amazing children; daughter Parker, who died of cancer in 2001, daughter Piper who came along to save him in 2002, and wild-man Chance born in 2004 who, either because or despite his Down Syndrome, is the frat brother Jon never had.

Among his many recognitions, *5280 Magazine* twice named him one of the top 10 most influential men in Denver. *Westword* awarded Caldara Denver's Best Media Manipulator. The *Denver Post* put Caldara on their list of people to watch. The State Policy Network honored him with the Thomas Roe Award. The Colorado Jaycees named him Outstanding Young Coloradoan.

Mike Krause is Director of Public Affairs, and heads up the Local Colorado Project, the Independence Institute's municipal-level policy effort. In addition he produces the Institute's public affairs television show, *Devil's Advocate*, and edits the Institute's state-wide editorial syndicate.

Linda Gorman is Director of the Health Care Policy Center at the Independence Institute, a state-based free market think tank in Denver, Colorado.

A former academic economist, she is the author of numerous articles in professional journals, periodicals, newspapers, and specialist blogs discussing the how government creates problems in health care, and what we can do to solve them. ALEXANDRIA, Va. – The National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) will take its nationwide “Destination: White House” campaign to several western and southwestern states over the next several weeks.

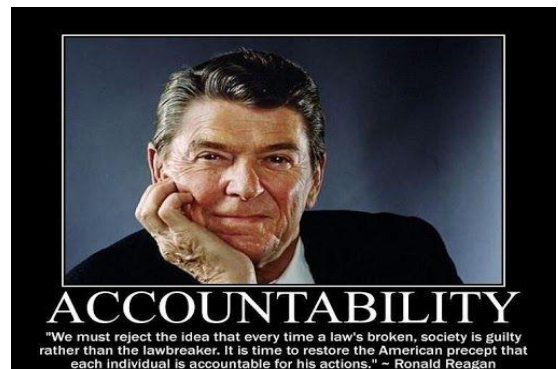

Constitution Week is the commemoration of America's most important document. It is celebrated annually during the week of September 17-23.

The United States Constitution stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans throughout history to maintain their liberties, freedoms and inalienable rights.

This celebration of the Constitution was started by the Daughters of the American Revolution. In 1955, DAR petitioned Congress to set aside September 17-23 annually to be dedicated for the observance of Constitution Week. The resolution was later adopted by the U.S. Congress and signed into public law on August 2, 1956, by President Dwight D. Eisenhower.

The DAR has also erected a structure that is built in tribute to the Constitution of the United States. DAR Constitution Hall, which is a performing arts center, opened in 1929.

The aims of the Constitution Week celebration are to:

- Emphasize citizens' responsibilities for protecting and defending the Constitution.
- Inform people that the Constitution is the basis for America's great heritage and the foundation for our way of life.
- Encourage the study of the historical events which led to the framing of the Constitution in September 1787.

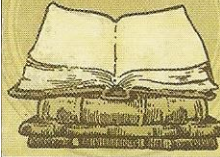
