John Voehl leads something of a double life. A retired Lockheed aerospace engineer from Littleton, he's also a husband and grandfather. But to thousands of people across the country, he's Abraham Lincoln, the 16th President of the U.S.

In his first 20 years of Lincoln work, John Voehl has provided over 1,100 Lincoln presentations and appearances in 42 states to become a nationally recognized Lincoln Historian and Presenter. John utilizes over 50 different motivational and historically accurate portrayals which exemplify Lincoln's virtuous and inspiring character traits, while making the persona of Abraham Lincoln come alive.

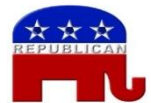

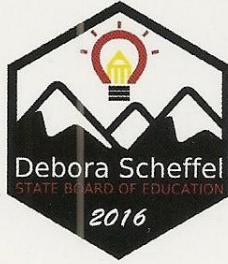

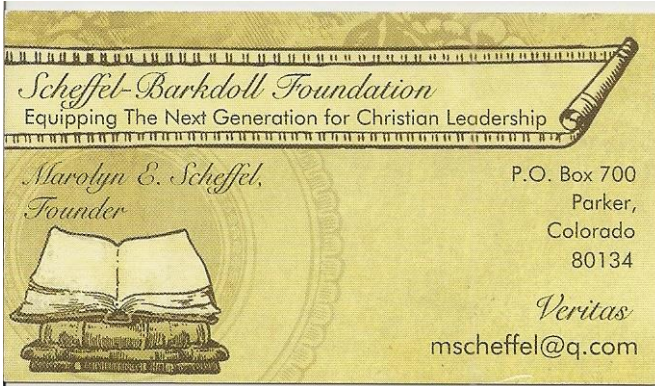
