Theron Walker grew up in Hamburg NY, suburban Buffalo. He studied theology as an undergraduate at Oral Roberts University majoring in Old Testament and minoring in modern Hebrew. He earned his Masters of Divinity at The Virginia Theological Seminary (Episcopal), and was ordained in 1996.

He has been living in Colorado with his wife, Denise, and son, Cullen, since 2000, and in Castle Rock since 2006. He is the founding pastor of Emmaus Anglican Church in Castle Rock (2010). He is interested in the intersection of faith, freedom, and virtue, and their place in public life.

Besides pastoring and family life, you might find him in his wood shop or on one of Colorado's trails with his Border Collie, Lincoln.






