He has served as campaign manager for many successful candidates for State and Federal offices in Colorado, South Dakota and Montana. Wadhams was campaign manager for Colorado Governor Bill Owens in 1998 when Owens became the first Republican Governor to be elected in 28 years.

Dick Wadhams is one of our most knowledgeable and informative resources on Colorado and Republican politics. He is a native of rural, southwestern Colorado and is a graduate of Colorado State University

David Flaherty is the CEO and founder of Magellan Strategies.
