Amy Oliver Cooke is the Executive V.P. and Director of the Energy and Environmental Policy Center for the Independence Institute, Colorado's free market think tank. She is one of our original Free-Market energy policy advocates and is famous for her provocative messages like "Mothers in Love with Fracking" and "I'm an energy feminist because I'm pro-choice in energy sources."

She founded a Colorado non-profit organization the Coalition of Ratepayers to provide a voice for captive ratepayers. Amy was the second person named to President Trump's Transition Team for the EPA. Amy is also a senior fellow with the influential Independent Women's Forum and on the board for the Steamboat Institute.

Ms. Cook's articles have appeared in numerous publications and newspapers and she has appeared on Fox News, MSN.com and other local programs as an energy policy expert.

You may know Amy from her radio show The Amy Oliver Show from which she retired in 2015. She was recognized in 2011 with the Award of Merit for Best News Talk personality in a major market.

Amy has a degree in Journalism from the University of Missouri and a Master's Degree in American History from UNC. Amy describes herself as a wife and mother and unapologetic free-market capitalist.

- **Mission Statement:** Project Sanctuary takes our military families from battle-ready to family-ready by providing six-day, outdoor, therapeutic retreats in a healing environment and ongoing family support services for two years following each retreat.

Member Survey Results

THANK YOU to those who completed our member survey. We received 49 replies, and we appreciate your feedback--always.

How did you respond?

- 69% of you have attended 3 or more meetings since September of 2018
