Giving Thanks to Legendary Ladies Who Led the Way: Mother Jones - Labor Activist; Maud Nelson - Bloomer League Baseball Star; Dr. Byrd Howell Granger — WASP (Women Air Force Service Pilots); Molly Brown - Philanthropist

The Legendary Ladies, founded in 1992, grew from early member' mutual love of women's history, costumes and performance. Known for the first 13 years as The Shady Ladies, the group participated in a variety of parades and festivals and developed their signature performance, "Unconventional Women of the West."

In 2005, members voted for a change of name to The Legendary Ladies, deciding to focus more on historical performance. As a result, members have researched and written scripts for one to five or more different women from the time period of the mid-1800's to the mid-1900's.

The mission of the group is to promote the history of women who made unique contributions to the West.

# We've chosen the Help & Hope Center-Douglas/Elbert Task Force to receive donations from our table buckets in October and November.

The Douglas/Elbert Task Force Help & Hope Center is a 501(c)3 non-profit human service organization providing assistance to people in Douglas and Elbert counties who are in serious economic need, at risk of homelessness, or in a similar crisis.

Since 1984, they have addressed immediate needs by consistently providing food and other necessities for homeless, low income and the working poor in our community. The Help & Hope Center meets these challenges with over 290 volunteers, three full-time and ten part-time staff. People who are in crisis operate under incredible stress. Having a calm, warm, quiet place to come, and being made welcome by a smiling volunteer, immediately diffuses some of that stress. For the kids, there is an airy, quiet space with room for them to play safely.




