I just returned from the NFRW Convention in Indianapolis, home state of our Vice President Mike Pence. Jimmy Sengenberger, 29, has been active in the Republican Party since the ripe old age of 13. For six years, he's hosted *The Jimmy Sengenberger Show*, a three-hour weekend radio program Saturday nights from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. MTN on Denver's News/Talk 710 KNUS. For over 2.5 years, Jimmy hosted *Business for Breakfast with Jimmy Sengenberger*, a morning show on Denver's KDMT 1690 AM. He is also a columnist for *Colorado Politics* and has written for a number of national publications including *The Federalist*, *The Washington Examiner*, *The Weekly Standard*, and *MarketWatch*.

A rising commentator on the Colorado and national stage, Jimmy has been nationally recognized as a leading conservative, such as being placed on 2018 a list of "11 Up and Coming Young Conservatives You Should Know About" by *Western Journal* and in 2016 and 2017 was listed by *Newsmax* as one of "30 Most Influential Republicans Under 30" nationally. Jimmy also serves as President and CEO of the Liberty Day Institute, where he established and oversees the Millennial Policy Center, and performs harmonica with bands in the Denver-Metro area from time to time.

For the kids, there is an airy, quiet space with room for them to play safely.

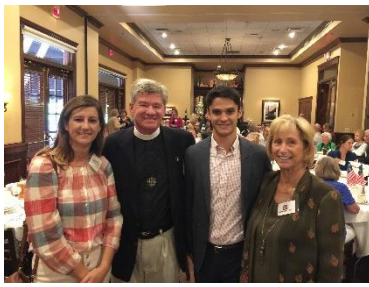

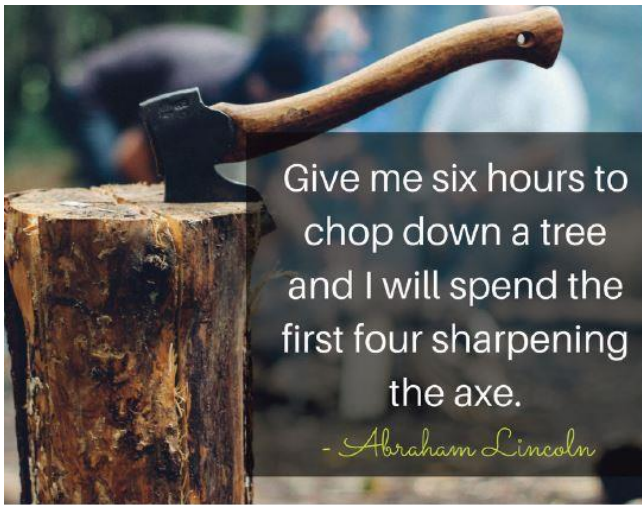
