**Holly Nicholson-Kluth** is the Undersheriff of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office. She was sworn in as Undersheriff on July 23, 2014. As Undersheriff, she oversees almost 700 deputies, civilians and volunteers and the DCSO's \$62 million dollar budget.

Holly started her career with DCSO in 1989 in the Patrol Division and has served in almost every division in the Sheriff's Office since then. Previous to being appointed Undersheriff she served as the Chief of the Administrative Services Bureau for 4 years, which oversees Detention and Court Security, Civil and Warrants, Information Technology and Dispatch. Previous to that she served as the Chief of the Law Enforcement Bureau for 4 years, which oversees the Patrol and Investigations divisions. She also served as Director of the Colorado Regional Computer Forensics Laboratory from 2001 through 2004 and has specialized training in Computer Forensics.

Her interests and special training have included crimes against children, computer crimes, technology, officer wellness, and leadership.

Holly has a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and holds her master's degree from Regis University in Psychology with studies in Forensic and Organizational Psychology, as well as Adult Learning. Holly attended and graduated from the FBI National Academy in Quantico Virginia in 2014. Holly lives in Douglas County and is married with two grown children and two grandchildren.






